History of the Moonee Ponds Courthouse

The Moonee Ponds Courthouse was built in 1890 and served as a Courthouse until the 1960's. For some years after this the Government wanted to demolish the building to make way for a car park for the police station next door. Due to the hard work of former members of the Essendon Historical Society (EHS) it was preserved and the Society became the Committee of Management for the site, operating as a Museum and a repository for local history.

During some restoration work earlier this year, a fire broke out in the roof and destroyed much of the main Courtroom. Luckily most of the records were saved.

The EHS is currently located in the Niddrie Library pending fund raising activities to restore the building, organised in conjunction with the local State MP Danny Pearson.
